## Ukpeagvik Iñupiat Corporation Class "B" Stock Application Instructions

On December 3, 2022, at a Special Meeting of Shareholders held in Utqiagʻvik, Alaska, Ukpeagʻvik Iñupiat Corporation ("UIC") shareholders approved SR 2022-01, authorizing UIC to issue Class B settlement common stock to eligible descendants of original UIC shareholders.

All applicants must be at least 18 years old to apply. UIC will begin accepting applications for  $1^{st}$  generation descendants of original UIC Shareholders in January 2023. UIC <u>will not</u> accept applications for  $2^{nd}$  generation descendants of original UIC Shareholders until January 2025.

Individuals are eligible to apply to receive 50 shares of Class B settlement common stock from UIC if they meet **all** of the following criteria:

- a. Born after December 18, 1971;
- b. Are at least 18 years old;
- c. Are not enrolled as a shareholder in any other urban, group, or village corporation organized pursuant to ANCSA, <u>except</u> because of inheriting or receiving a gift of shares from another such corporation;
- d. Are a child or grandchild by blood or adoption of at least one original UIC shareholder to whom UIC issued Class A shares pursuant to Section 5 of ANCSA in 1973;
- e. Are a descendant of a Native (as defined in ANCSA); and
- f. Are a citizen of the United States.

	<b>Birth Certificate.</b> This is required for all applicants. UIC uses birth certificates to confirm that the applicant was born after December 18, 1971, that the applicant is over the age of 18, and that the applicant <b>was born in the U.S.</b> and is therefore a U.S. Citizen.
You may also need to provide <b>photocopies</b> of the following documents:	
	<b>Proof of U.S. Citizenship.</b> This is required for all applicants <b>whose birth certificate does not show they were born in the U.S.</b> UIC will accept a U.S. passport identification page or naturalization certificate.
	cultural adoption. This is only required if the applicant was adopted.
	<b>Confirmation of a Legal Name Change.</b> This is only required if the applicant's
	first or last name was changed from the name that appeared on the applicant's original birth certificate, please provide a new social security
	card, passport, or other government identification showing the new name.

	<b>Guardianship</b> . This is only required if the applicant is under a court-ordered conservatorship or guardianship.
